| <p>1. Massachusetts Government Act - May 20, 1774:</p> <p>Took away the colonists charter, their rights for self-government and put the British governor in control of the government.</p> | | |
| <p>2. Administration of Justice Act - May 20, 1774:</p> <p>British officials accused of committing crimes could not be tried in local courts but could be sent back to England for trials.</p> | | |
| <p>3. Boston Port Act – June 1, 1774:</p> <p>Closed the port of Boston until the East India Tea Company was paid for the lost tea.</p> | | |
| <p>4. Quartering Act – June 2, 1774:</p> <p>British troops were to be quartered in public buildings at the expense of the colonists or quartered in the colonists' homes. This act applied to all colonies, not just Massachusetts.</p> | | |
