The story can be told from any perspective, and might be an overview of the whole period, or look at a specific aspect of it (war, civilians, technology, social groups, etc.).

Provide a **creative** title for your story, the authors (your group members), and the theme about the Civil War period that your story will convey. Then, for each photo you select, please provide a brief description, a text caption for that image that explains how it represents your theme (at least 2-3 sentences for each image), and list any additional evidence from your own knowledge of the Civil War that helps validate your story. Be prepared to share your stories with the class. Some questions to keep in mind: Why did you choose your theme? Why did you choose your images? What decisions did you make about what to include/leave out? What evidence supports your story? What evidence might be used to argue against your story?
